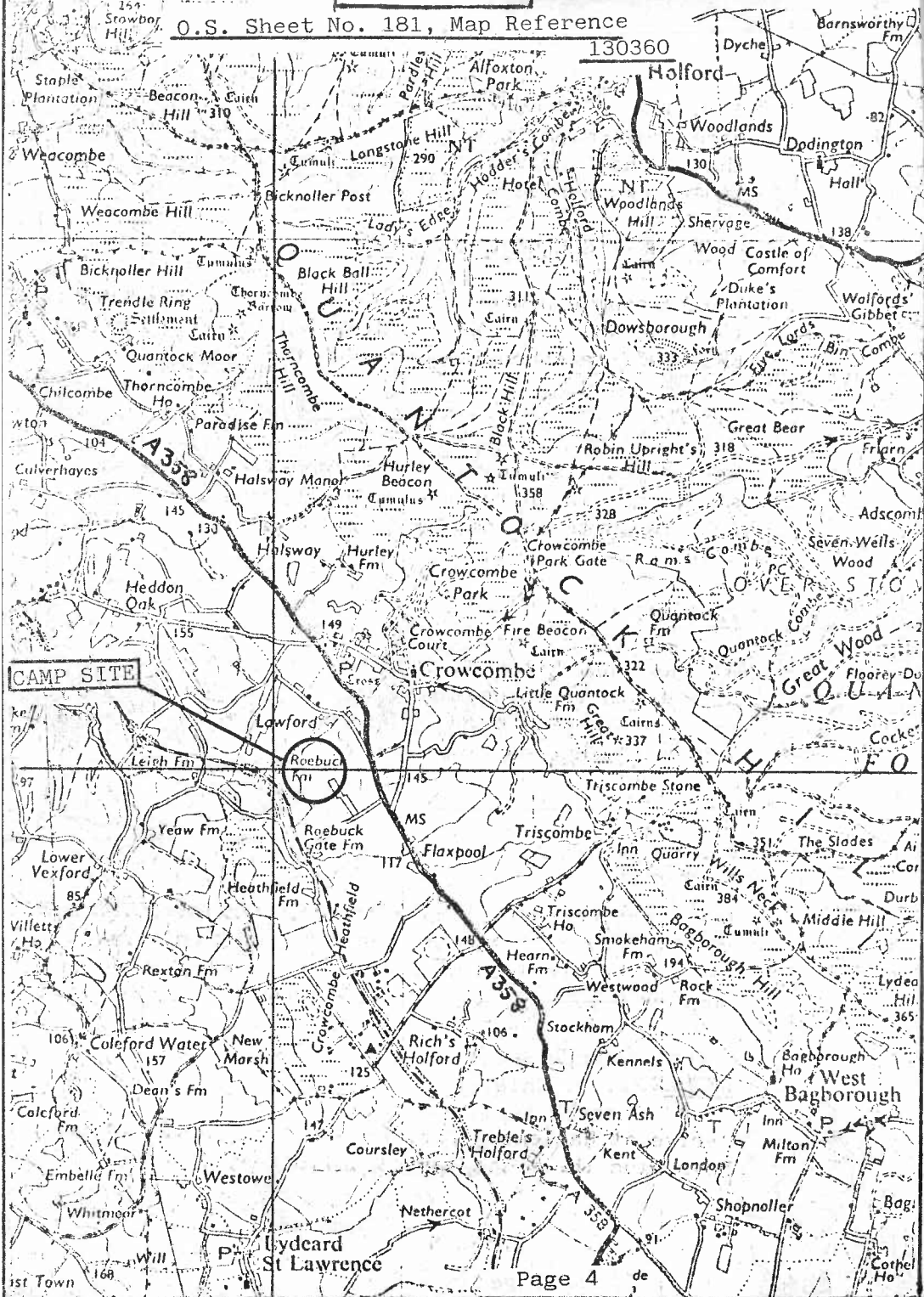
ROEBUCK FARM.

SPECIAL NOTES.

PERSONAL KIT.

All personal kit and extra luggage plus personal hike tents to be delivered to Skips house (68 Marys Mead, Hazlemere) during the hours of 6.30 p.m. and 7 p.m. on Thursday, 31st July.

DEPARTURE.

Leave Hazlemere Parish Church car park at 10.00 a.m. on Saturday 2nd August, wearing Scout uniform. Also to be provided with a packed lunch for the journey.

RETURN.

Arrive at Hazlemere Parish Church car park 1-2 p.m. Boys plus their kit may be collected. (Please)

KIT LIST

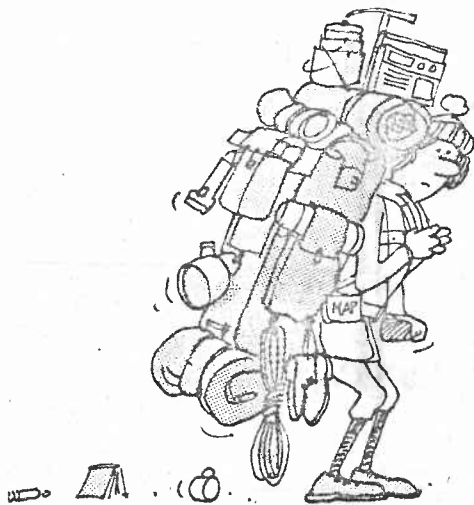
KIT LIST CONTINUED.

- Polythene Bags (For clean and dirty clothes).
- Duffle Bag or Carry All for picnics - swimming gear, etc.
- Sheathknife - This must be handed to SKIP as soon as you arrive. It will be returned when you participate in the appropriate project.
- They must NOT be worn when wearing Scout uniform.

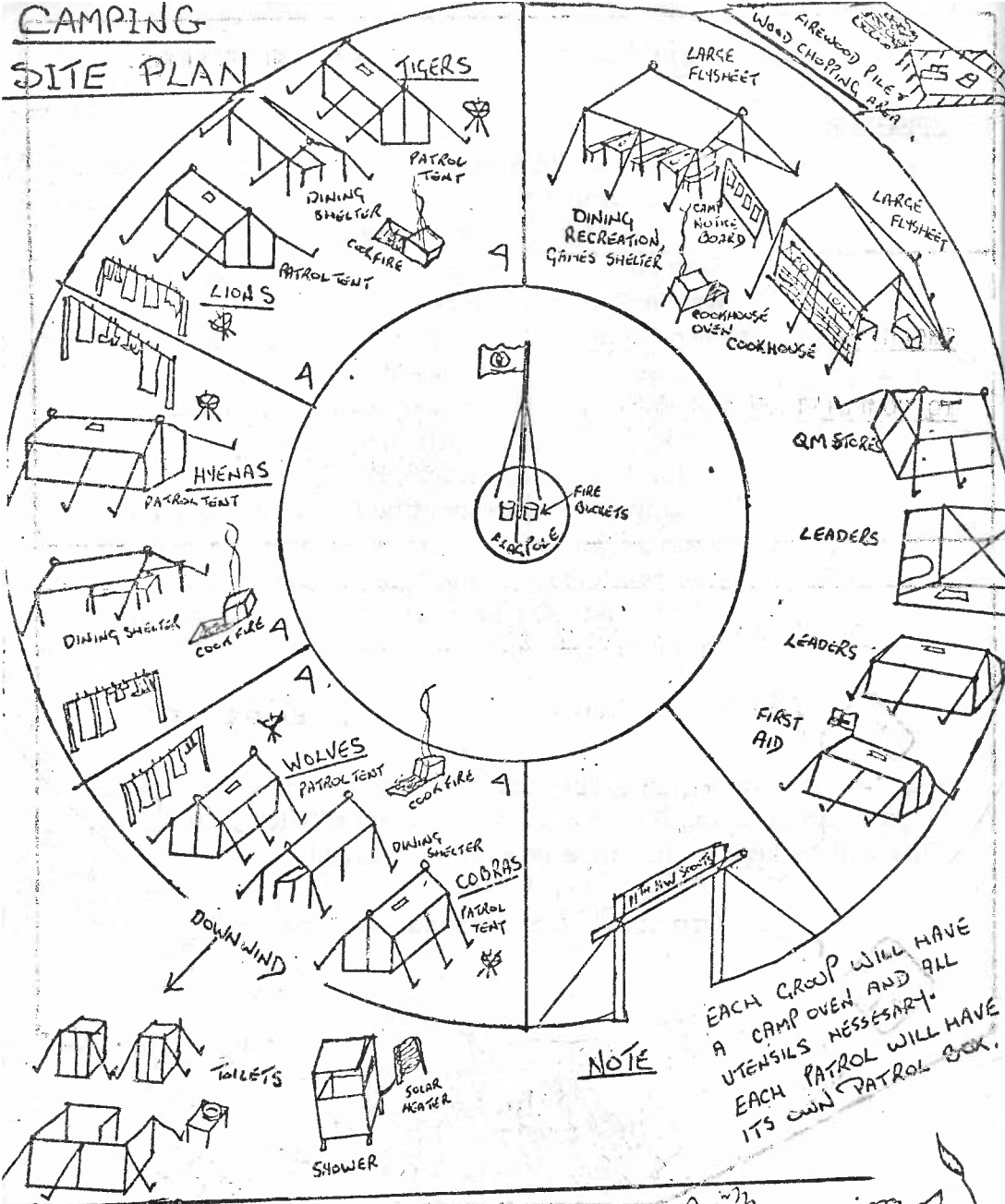
All kit to be packed into Rucksacks - spare and clean clothes can be packed into a small suitcase clearly marked with your name. This will be kept in the store tent until required.

CAMPING

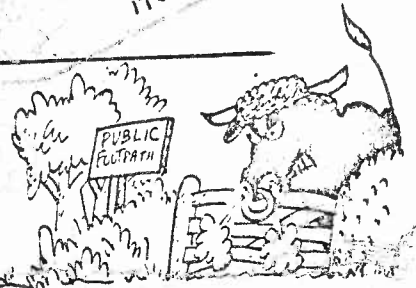
SITE PLAN

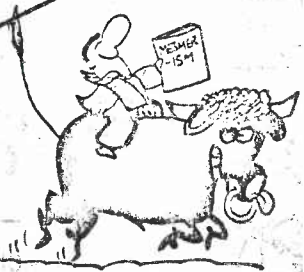
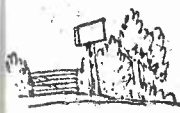
