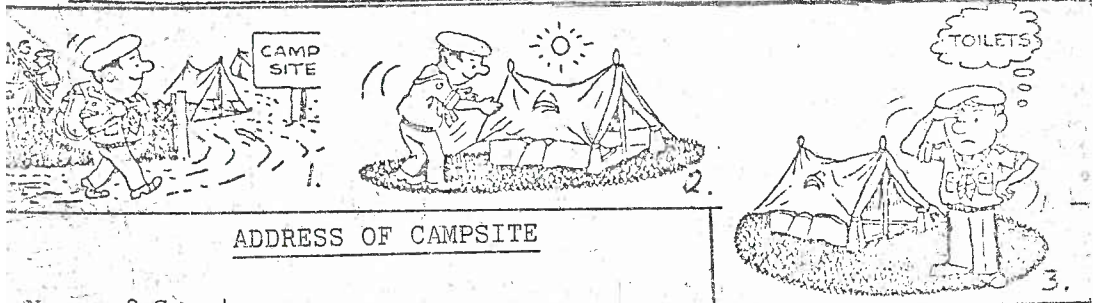
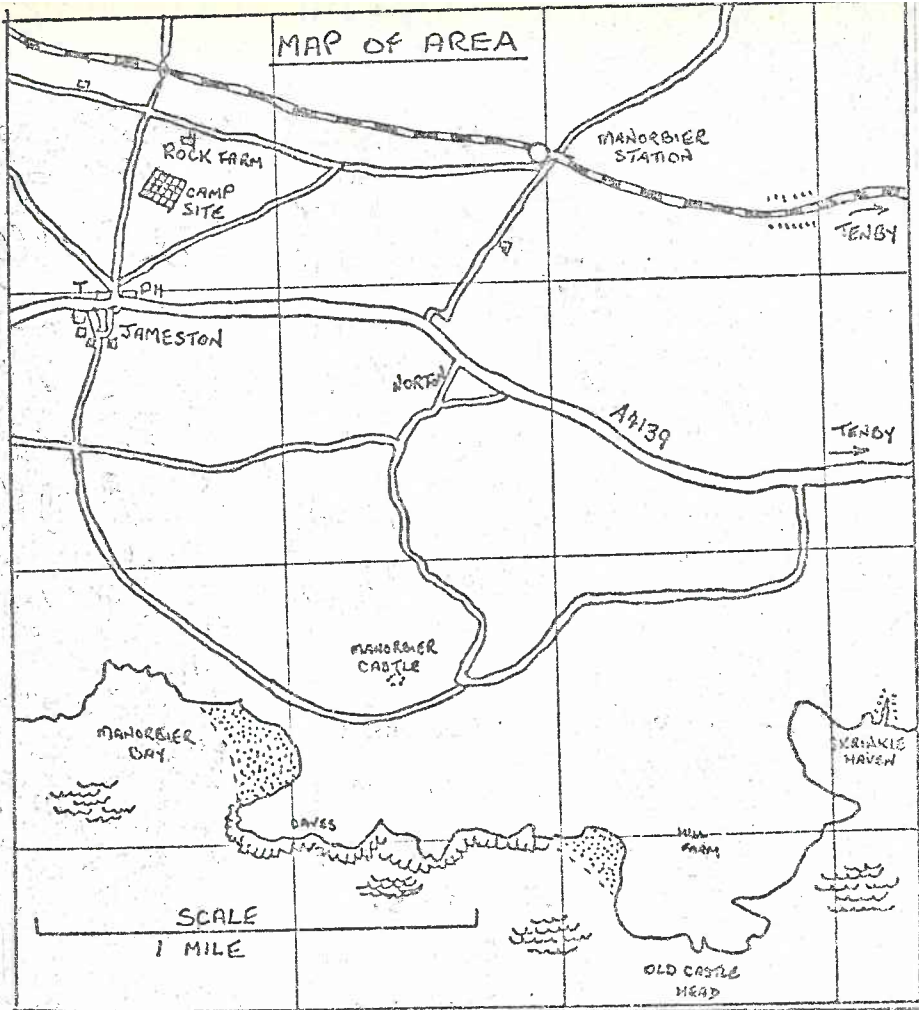

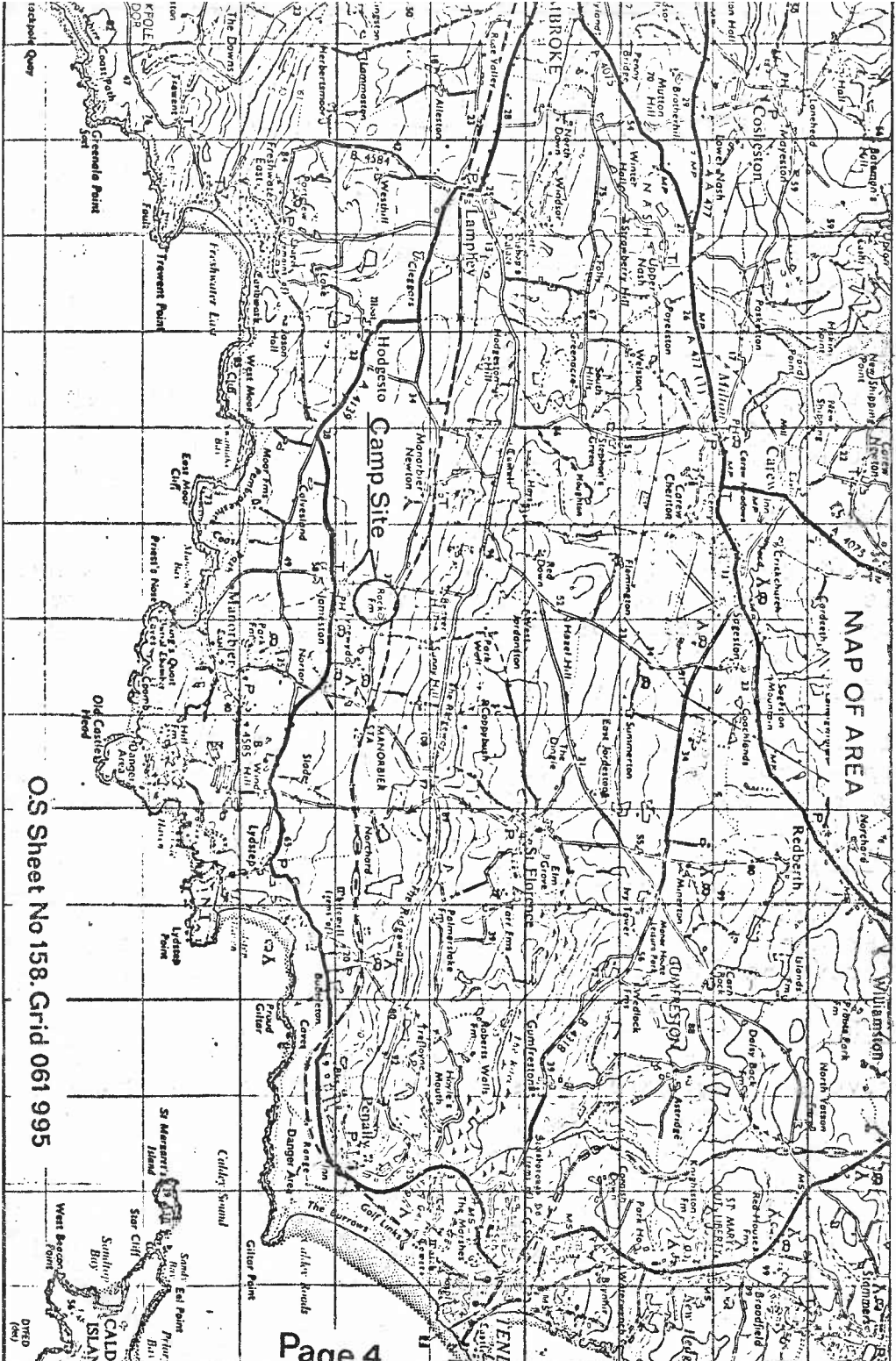

Polythene Bags (For clean and dirty clothes).

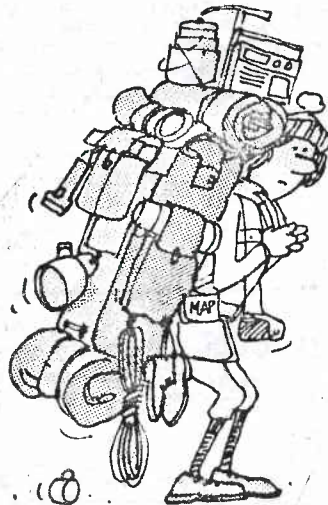
Duffle Bag or Carry All for picnics - swimming gear, etc.

Sheathknife - This must be handed to SKIP as soon as you arrive. It will be returned when you participate in the appropriate project.

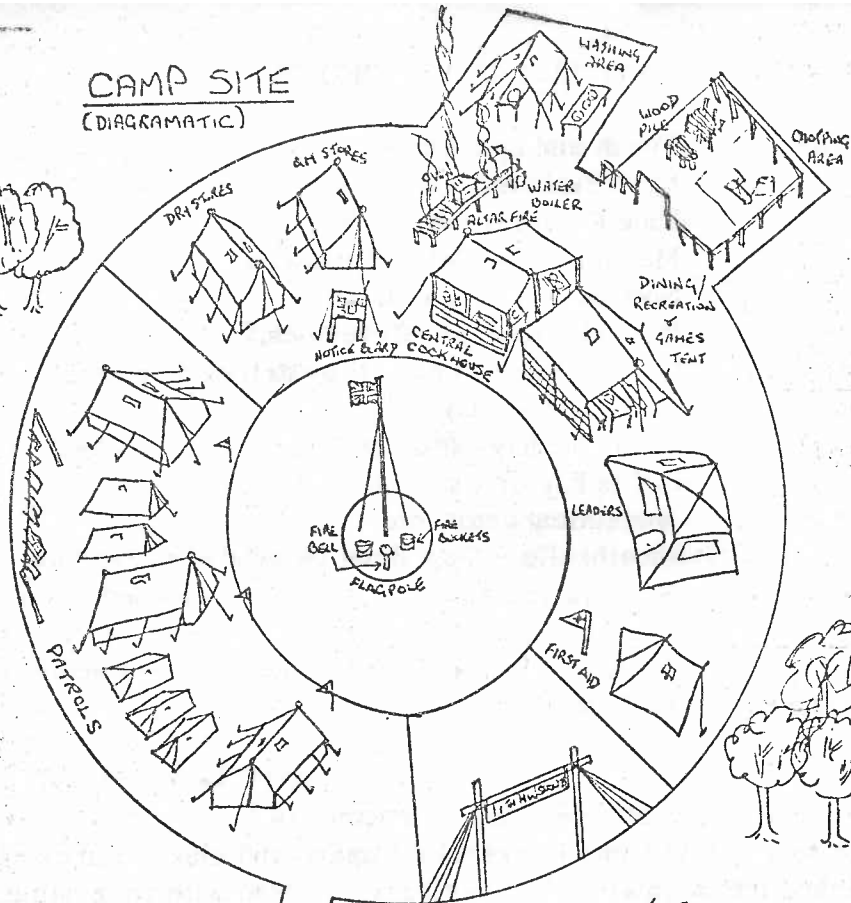
They must NOT be worn when wearing Scout uniform.

One stamped addressed postcard.

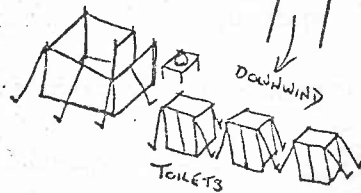


# CAMP SITE (DIAGRAMATIC)
