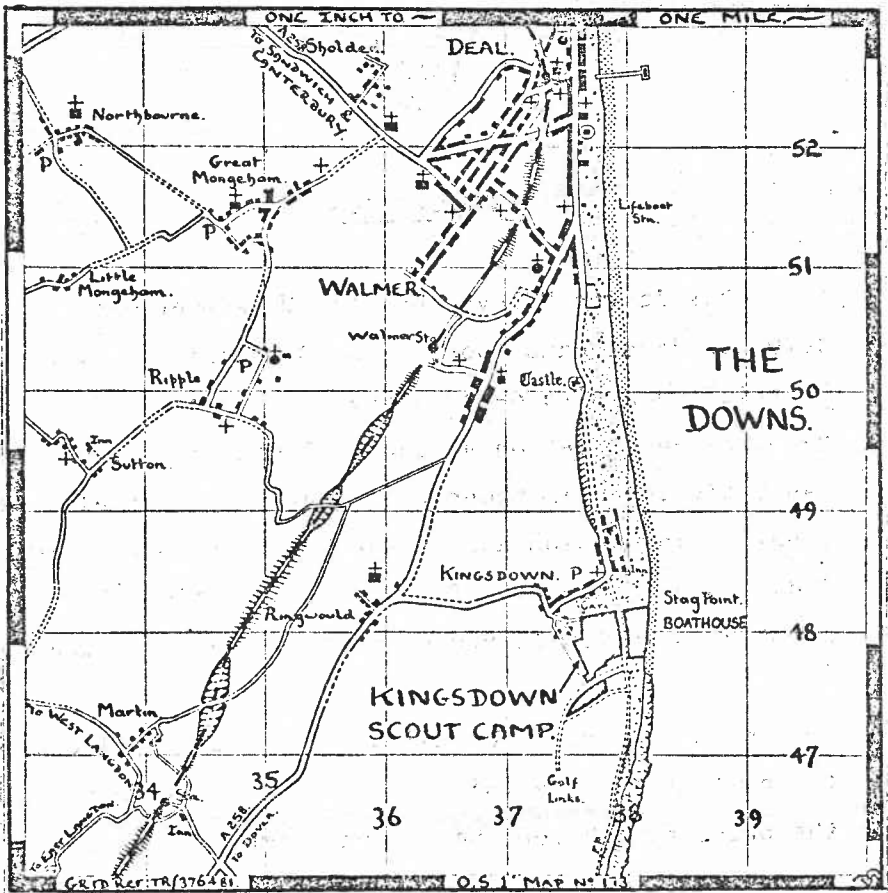
INTRODUCTION

This leaflet is intended to hopefully answer many of the questions that may arise, but please feel free to contact any of the Scout leaders should you have any further queries.

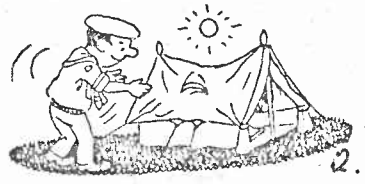
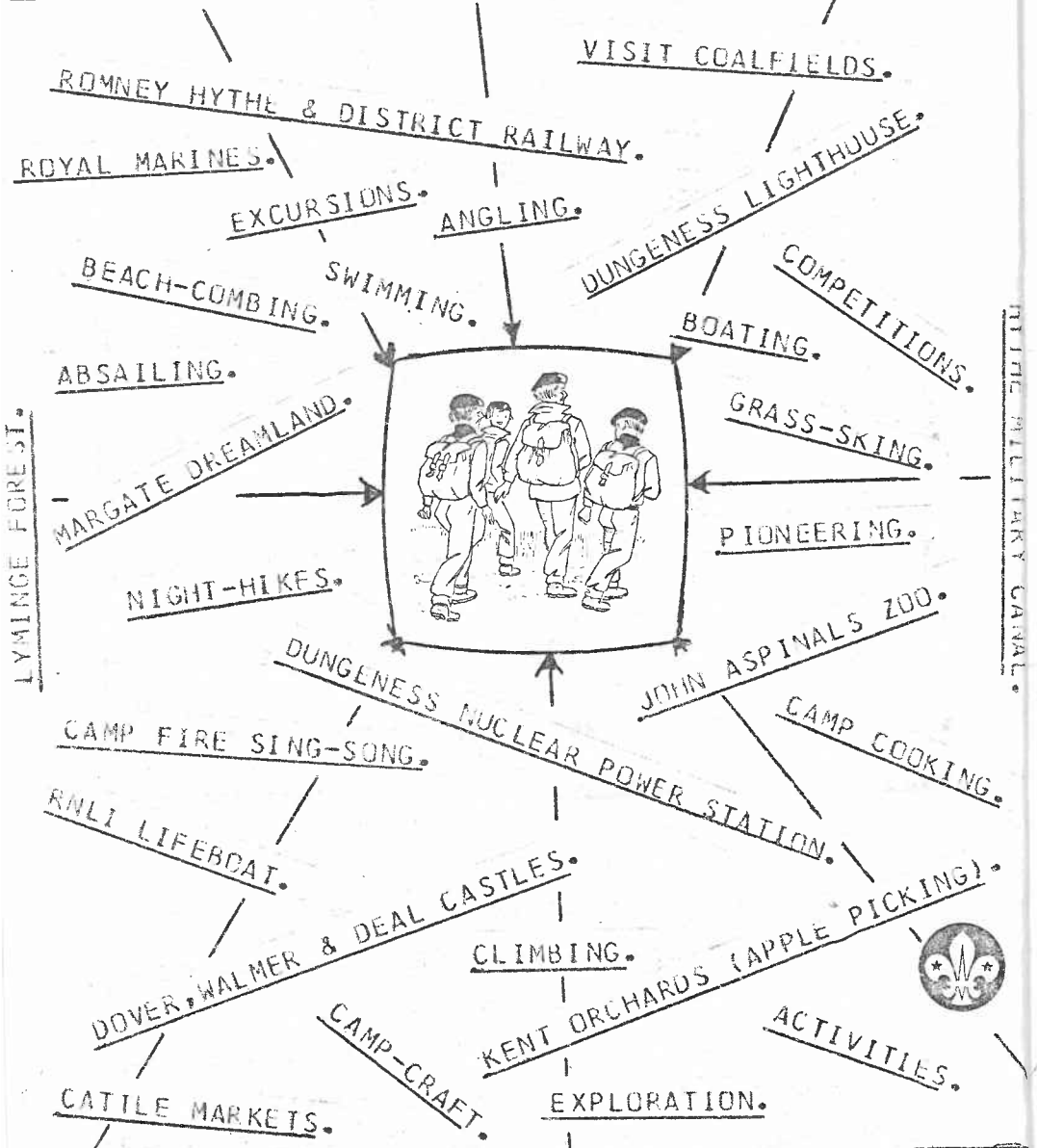

Polythene Bags (For clean and dirty clothes).

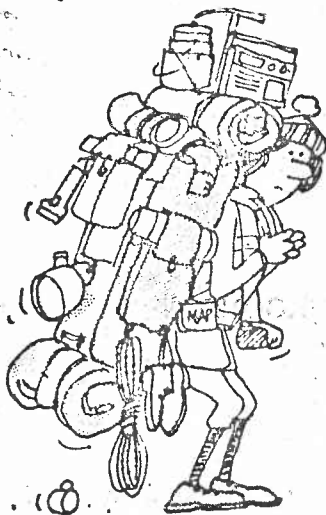
Duffle Bag or Carry All for picnics - swimming gear, etc.
