## GUERNSEY - GENERAL INFORMATION



### The Bailwick of Guernsey

Guernsey, together with its smaller dependencies of Alderney, Sark and Herm, form a self governing group of Channel Islands known as the Bailwick of Guernsey.

The Bailwick is situated in the Gulf of St. Malo, about 30 miles from the Normandy coast of France and 80 miles from the south coast of England.

### Language

English is the official language, some legal documents are published in French, and a Norman patios is still used by the local families.

### Land Area

Approximately 24 square miles, with a coastline of 45 miles. The island slopes from south to north, the highest point being 338 feet at the airport.

### Currency


The States issues its own currency, both in notes and coins, but both Guernsey and English money is used, being of equal value -

100 pence = £1.00.

#### SPECIAL NOTES

#### The Address of the Camp Site

Name of Scout, 11th. High Wycombe, (Hazelmere) Scout Troop, Scout Camp Site, Rue Mainguy, Vale, Guernsey, Channel Islands.

#### Personal Kit

As space is at a premium, all personal kit is to be packed into rucksacks and will be carried. The exception is sleeping bags, which should be folded as small as possible and packed into a plastic bag and labelled. Sleeping bags and personal hike tents should be brought to H.Q. on Sunday July 22nd. at 10.30 a.m. for packing into mini-bus.

#### Travel

All the party will be travelling by coach to Waterloo Station. Then by British Rail to Weymouth to catch a Sealink Ferry to St. Peters Port, Guernsey, where another coach will transport the party to the camp site.

Times will be notified to you as soon as they are confirmed. The anticipated time of arrival at Hazelmere for the return journey is 7.30 p.m. Sunday 5th. August.

#### Food

A packed lunch is required for the outward journey.




