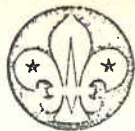

BRAGGERS WOOD.

AREA.

Eight acres of beautiful and secluded private woodlands on the edge of the New Forest.

Great views and vistas only minutes from the site which is set in the estate of Lord Manners.

Only five miles from the nearest beach, sea and sailing facilities. Within easy reach of numerous places of natural and historic interest.

The camp site is run by the Christchurch District Scout Council as a camping and training centre.

FACILITIES.

Special 60' x 20' Cabin for emergency use, First Aid room, Mains Water, Wash Basins, Flush Toilets, Provador with souvenirs sweets and limited groceries.

Open Air Chapel in quiet corner of the site. Camp Fire circle seating 400.

POST.

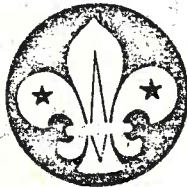
Post will be delivered to the Wardens Office.

Regret no radios allowed.



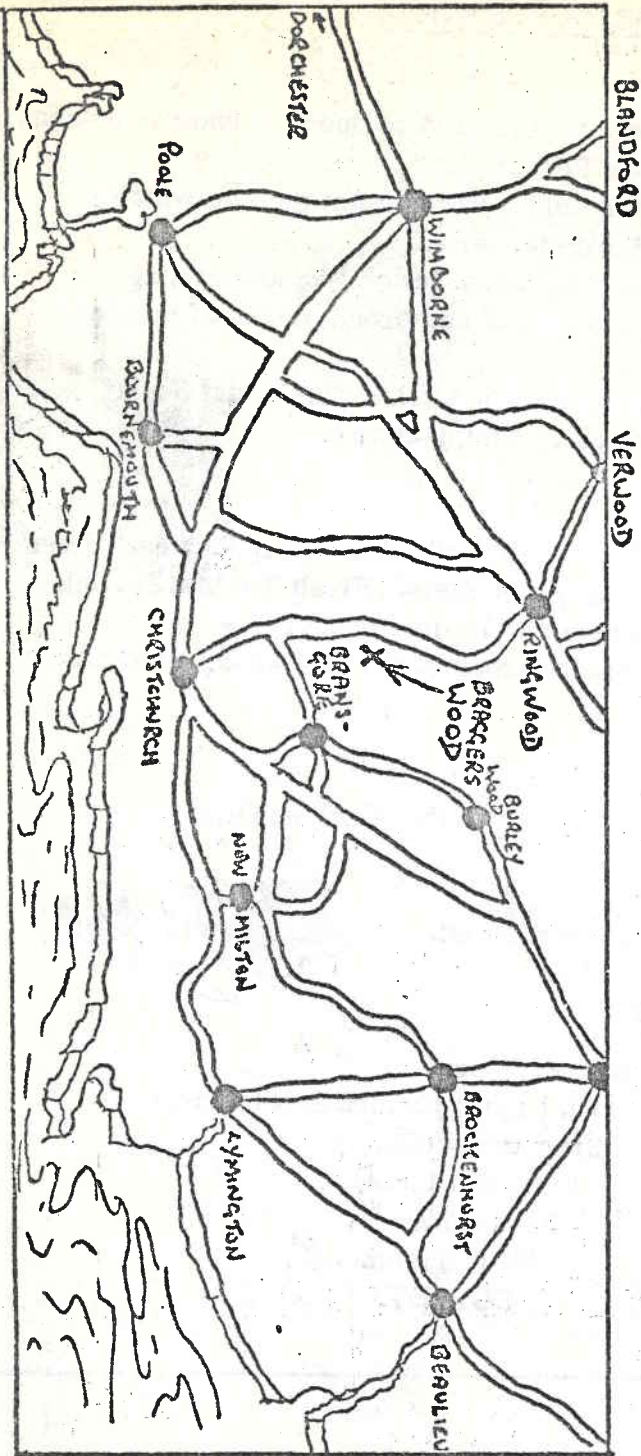

MAP OF AREA AND DIRECTIONS

Easiest approach is by Picket Post on A31. Map ref: 192/062 OS map 195. South to Buryley. Turn right in centre of village towards Bransgore. After about 2 miles turn right at cross-roads. Follow road down hill for about one mile and the site will be found on the right hand side.



SPECIAL NOTES

Each boy is to have a stamped addressed postcard or envelope, so that at least you will know that he has arrived safely. These will be posted on the second day of camp.

TIMES

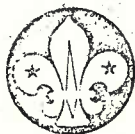
Timings, departures & arrivals will be announced at the parents evening on 9th July.

Duffle Bag or Carry All for picnics - swimming gear, etc.

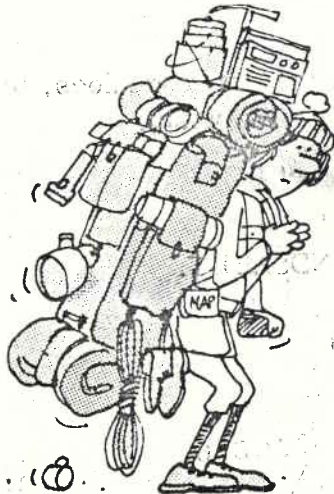
Sheathknife - This must be handed to SKIP as soon as you arrive. It will be returned when you participate in the appropriate project.

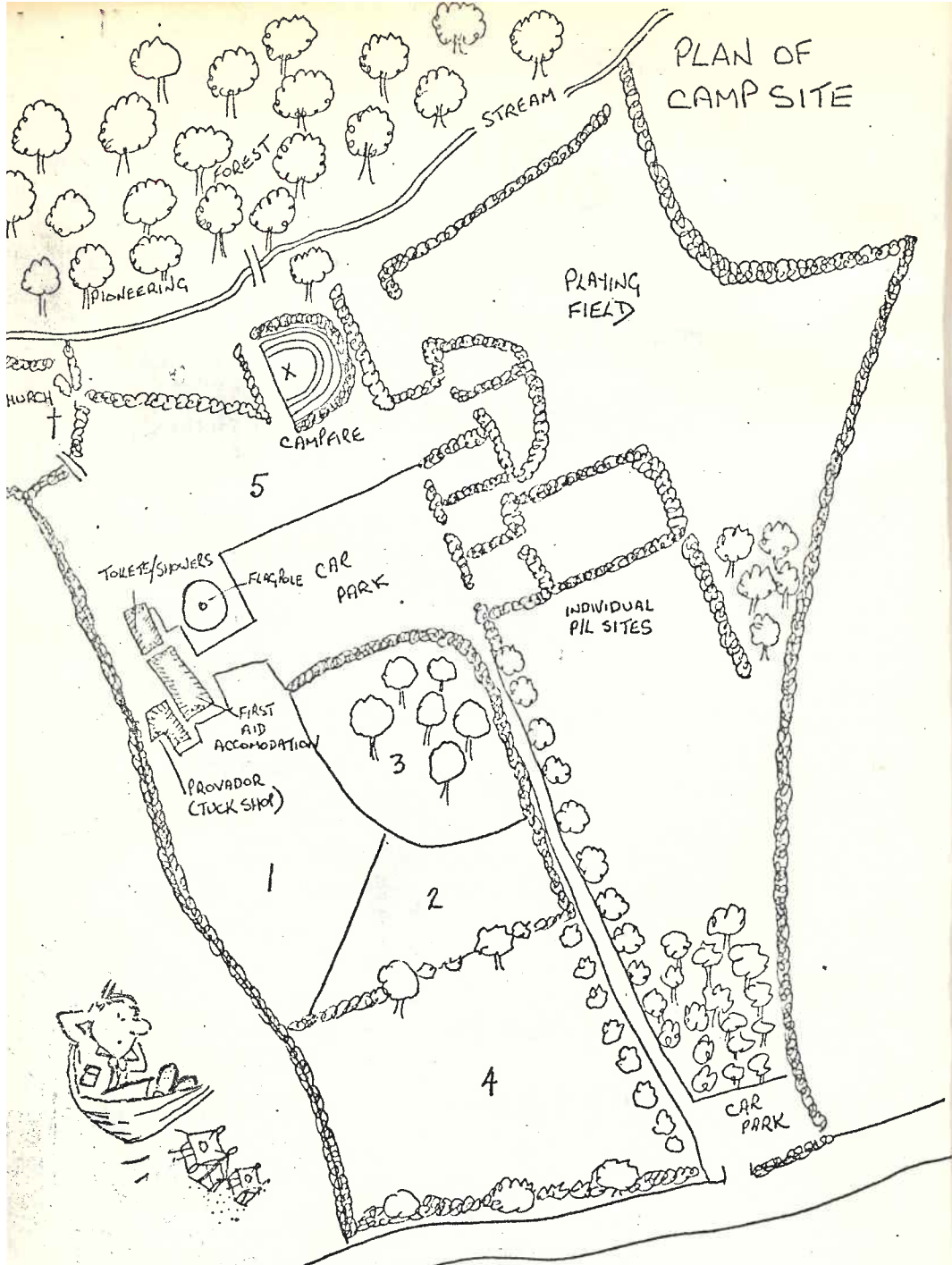
They must NOT be worn when wearing Scout uniform.

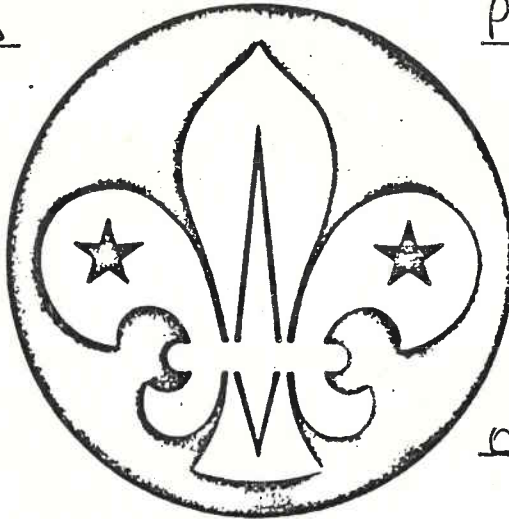

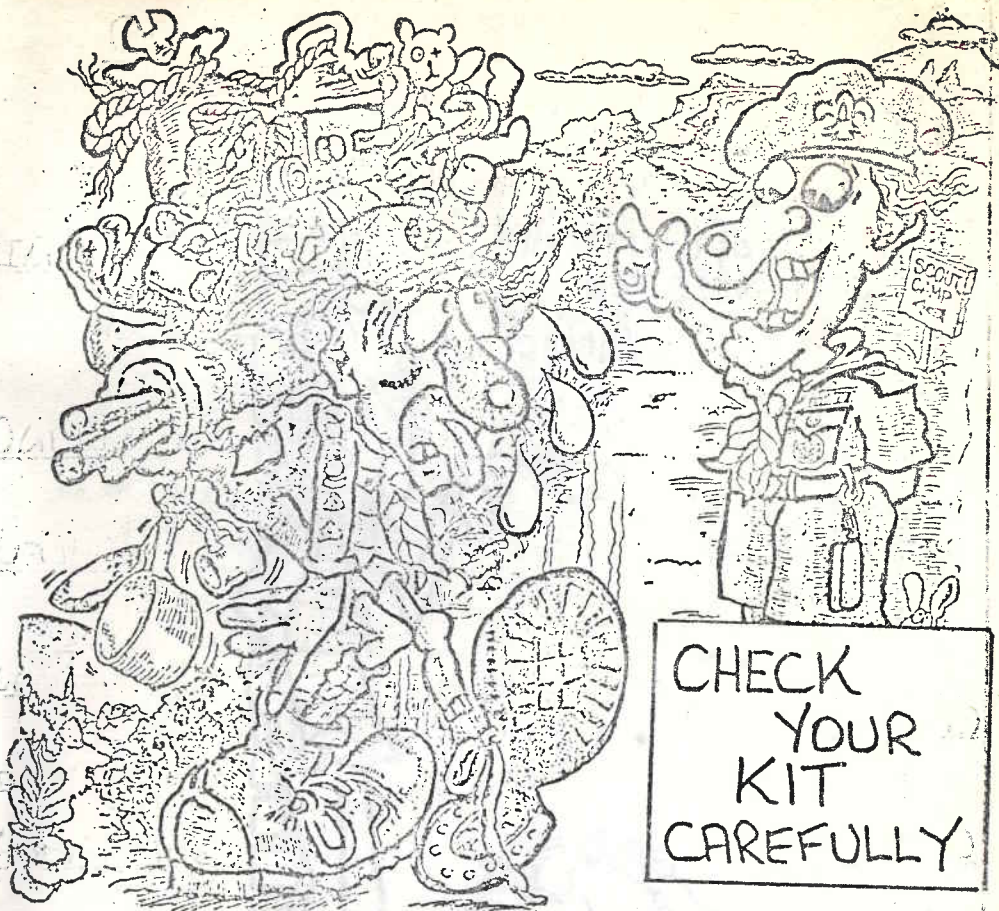
