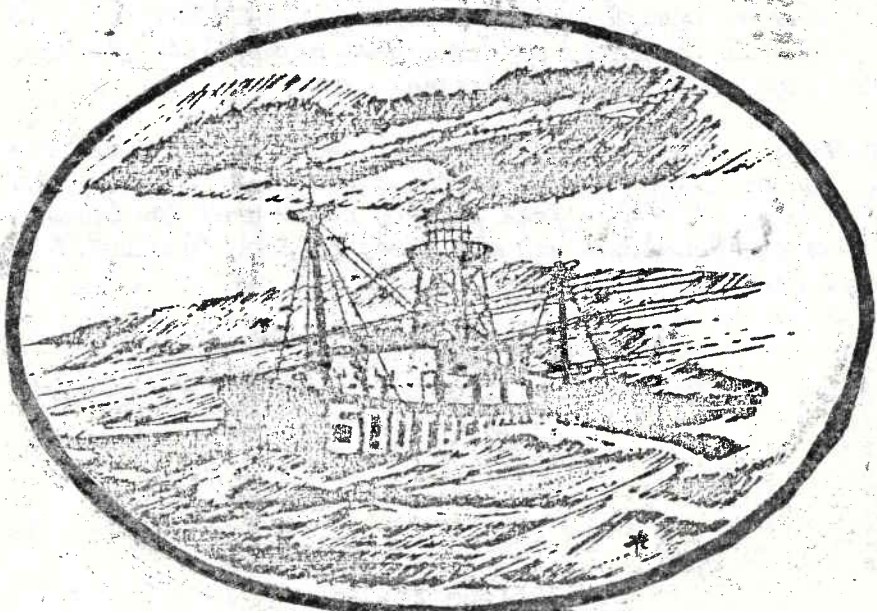

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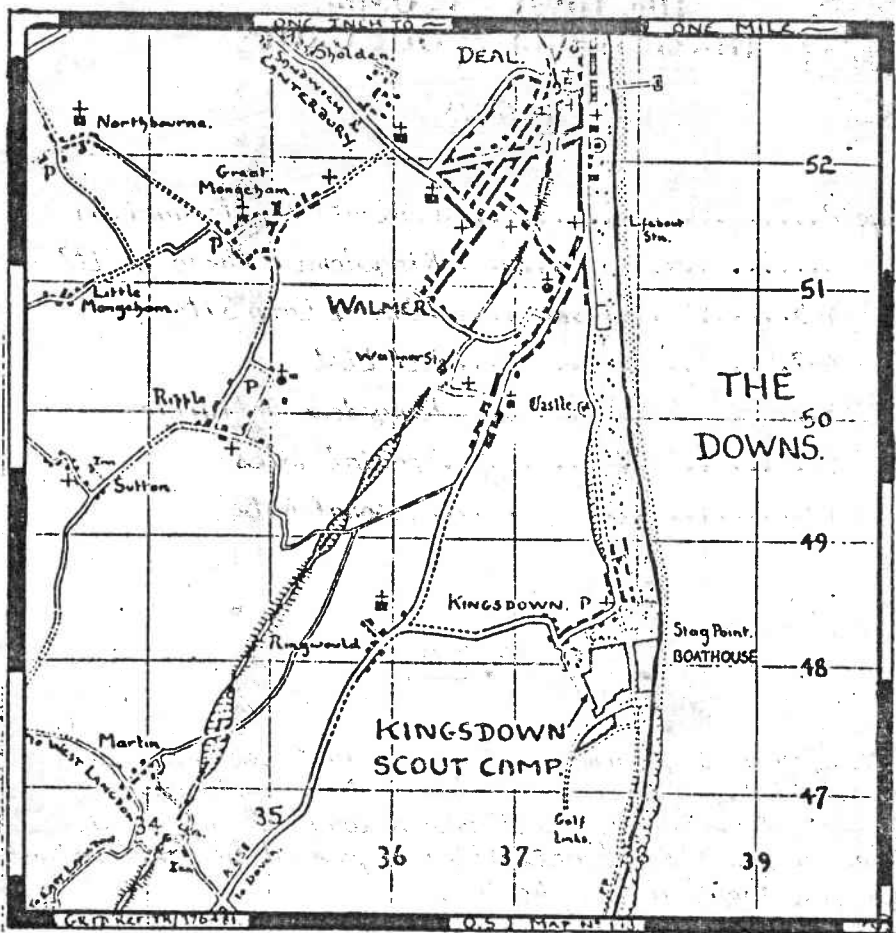
INTRODUCTION

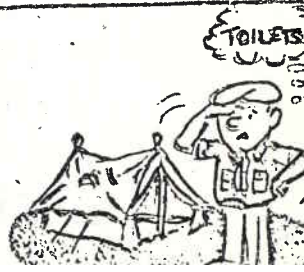
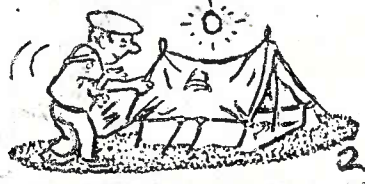
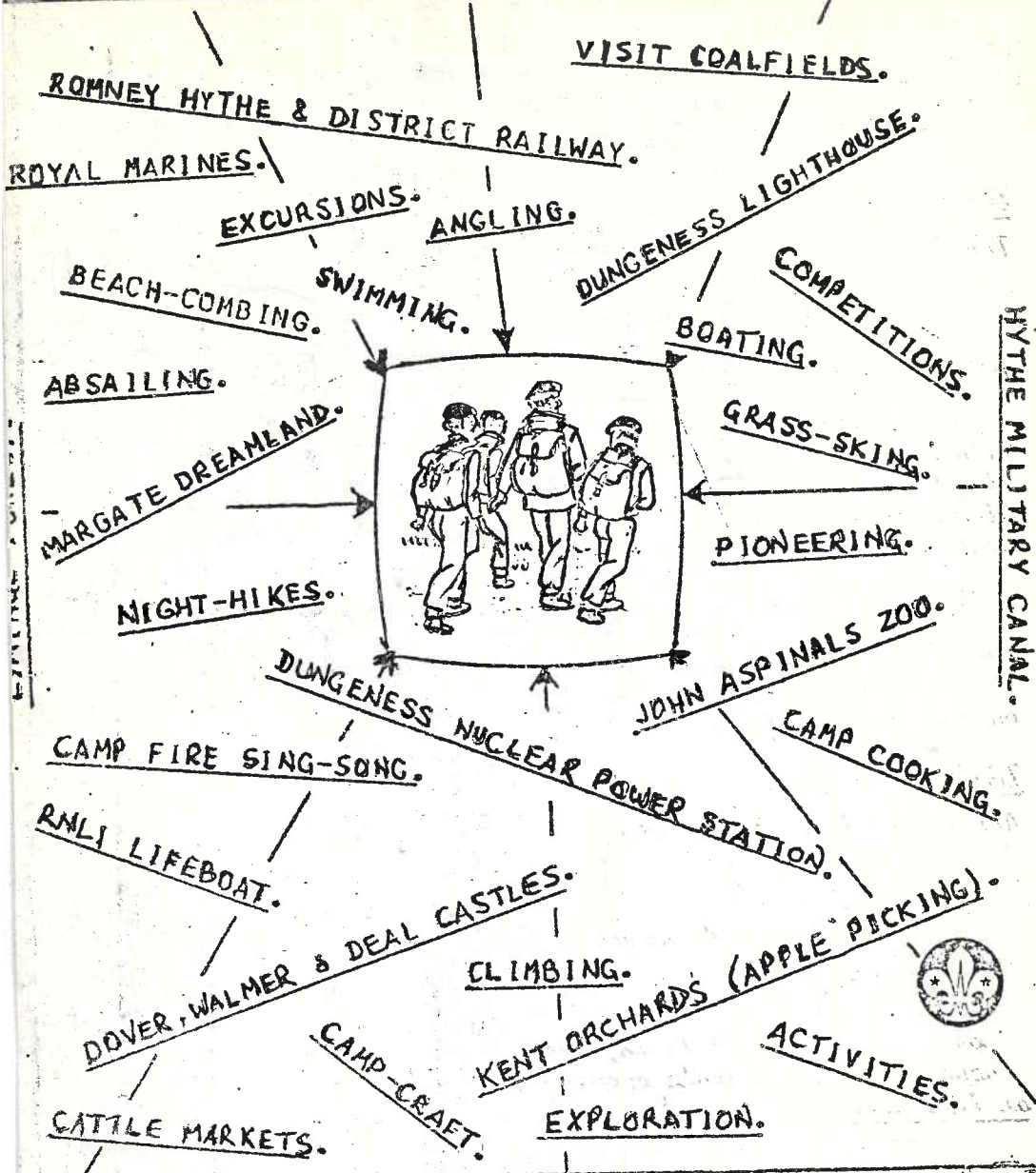
Torch and spare batteries.

All the party will be travelling in mini buses.

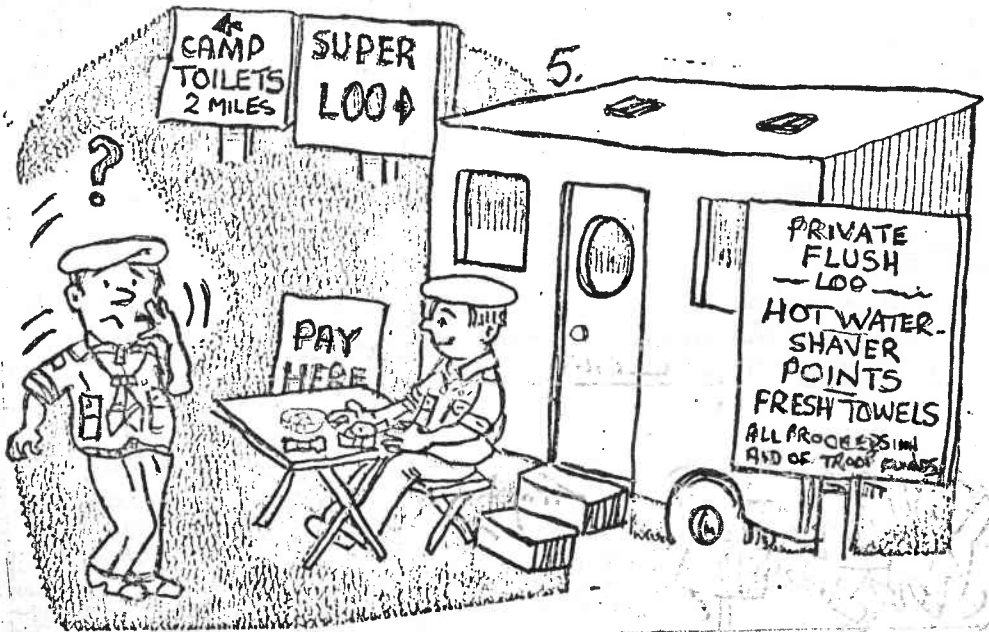
FOOD

Departure and arrival times, receipt of kit, etc., will be announced at the parents evening on Tuesday, April 29th at 7.30 p.m.







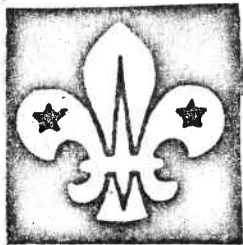
